Process:

Application forms may be found in person at the Scarborough Arts Council, online at www.scarborougharts.com, or via email (programs@scarborougharts.com). The Scarborough Arts Council must receive all entries by **5:00p.m. on Monday, December 7, 2009**. *Please ensure sufficient mailing time, as no entries will be accepted after this date.* Once all entries have been reviewed, the jury will select a list of finalists. Winners will be announced in December 2009. Winners and finalists will present their work at a group exhibition in January.

Formatting Your Images:

Digital images **MUST** be saved in **.jpeg format** only and submitted **on an appropriately labelled CD**. *No other formats, including gifs, bmps, tiffs, psds or e-mailed images will be accepted.* Digital images must be at least **72dpi** resolution. Digital prints are also acceptable, and must be printed at **300 dpi**.

What is a Curriculum Vitae?

A curriculum vitae, or 'CV' is similar to a resume. An artist's CV should give some idea of the artist's history and art-related experiences such as exhibitions (including school exhibitions), travel, art classes, design, special projects, paid and volunteer work. Examples of an artist's CV can easily be found on the internet.

What is an Artist Statement?

An artist statement is an explanation of why you make art, why you love art, or what you are trying to convey with your work. What attracts you to fine art? What is your work about?
